

CHROMA'S JO SONJA®

FACT SHEET

Green Verdigris

Materials required:

Jo Sonja's Teal Green Artists' Colours
Jo Sonja's Raw Umber Artists' Colours
Jo Sonja's Rich Gold Artists' Colours
Jo Sonja's Warm White Artists' Colours
Jo Sonja's Water Based Satin or Gloss Varnish

Base coating brush, stiff bristled brush for dry brushing, sea sponge

Directions:

1. Mix 3 parts Teal Green and 1 part Raw Umber together. Base coat item using base coating brush. Allow to dry, apply second coat if necessary.
2. Use any of the remaining paint mixture (3 parts Teal Green: 1 part Raw Umber) and mix in 1 part Warm White. Use damp, not wet, sea sponge to *lightly* apply this mixture across the item. Pattern should look 'dry' and powdery as opposed to clumps of colour. Try sponging a sample piece first until you are satisfied with the results.
3. When sponging is thoroughly dry, place Rich Gold on your palette. Use the stiff bristled brush to dip into the Gold and brush the excess off on an old cloth. Using a 'flicking' motion, lightly brush over your piece to achieve a delicate 'dry brushed' effect. Continue until you are satisfied with the result.
4. When thoroughly dry, apply 2 - 3 coats varnish to protect.
